The Summer Series

For the Summer Series this weekend we offer a reflection on Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament.

Many years ago I lived in the Tri Cities in central Washington. The parish in Richland, the specific city in which I lived, was named Christ the King. This parish had a Eucharistic Chapel similar to the one we have here in St. Olaf Church.

One day I was inspired to go and spend some time there. I came back the following week, and on subsequent weeks. Before long I discovered a desire within myself to spend time in the chapel regularly, and so I began making a visit on my way home from work. It was during this time that I made plans to enter the seminary. A personally very blessed, graced time.

I'm so thankful for the presence of that chapel in central Washington. I know I share the sentiments of many here locally in expressing my gratitude for the presence of our Blessed Sacrament Chapel in our parish. We invite any parishioners wishing to make a visit to the chapel to stop by the office for an electronic key.

It's common to visit the chapel on a weekly basis, as part of one's weekly routine. And people spend differing amounts of time in the chapel, ranging from 15 minutes to an hour each visit. There's no prescribed requirement.

Next week we'll continue this topic with a survey of some spiritual exercises one can perform while visiting our Chapel. These include silence, praying the rosary, reading, and journaling, among others.

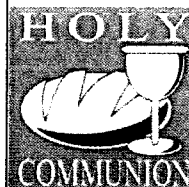


Eucharistic Ministry
