This book will be located at the corner of the altar, in the same place as the photos we bring. Simply come forward and write the names in the book. We'll have a special prayer for them throughout the first half of November.

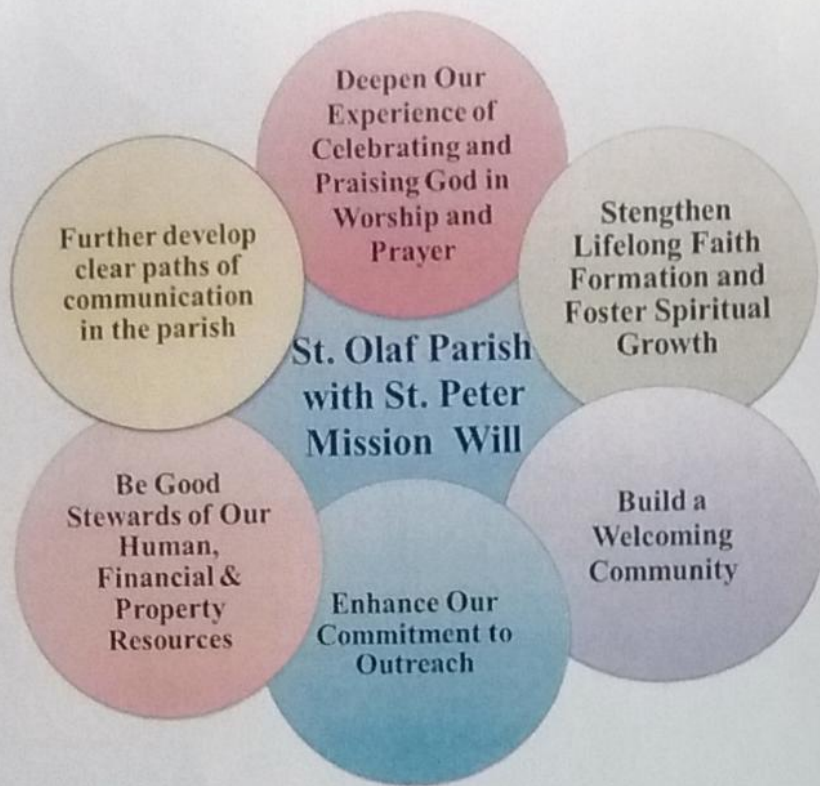

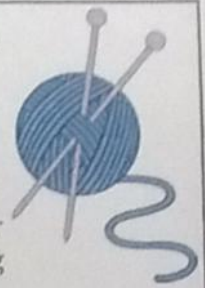

Further Paths of Communication

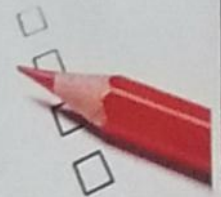

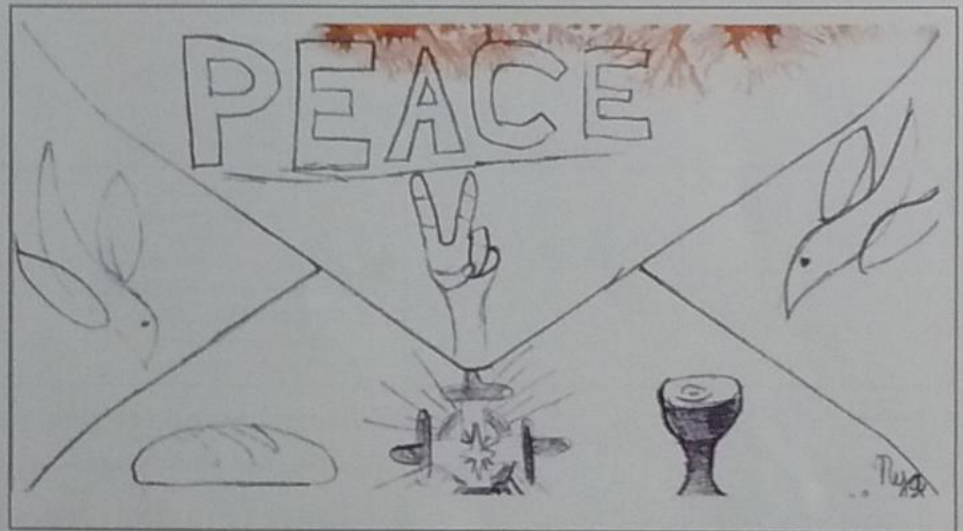
